

AKTA LEMBAGA PEMASARAN PERTANIAN PERSEKUTUAN, 1965

IN exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3 and 12 of the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority Act, 1965, the Authority with the approval of the Minister, hereby prescribes the following Regulations: *Act 141.*

1. (1) These Rules may be cited as the **Vegetable Marketing Regulations, 1975**, and shall have application throughout Malaysia and shall come into force on 1st April, 1975. *Citation, application and commencement.*

(2) The Authority, with the approval of the Minister, may by notification in the *Gazette* exempt any vegetable from the application of any or all the provisions of these Regulations. *[Am. P.U.(A)384/77]*

2. In these Regulations, unless the context otherwise requires — *Interpretation.*

"sale" includes offer for sale, expose for sale and keep for sale and the word "sell" shall be construed accordingly;

"sale by retail" means sale to a consumer;

"specified area" means an area declared as a specified area under regulation 3;

"vegetable" means vegetable specified in the Schedule hereto in their raw state:

"vegetable farmer" means a person who cultivates vegetables on land which belongs to him or in which he has an interest as lessee, tenant, occupier, licensee, assignee, chargee, successor in title, agent or in any other manner or capacity.

"wholesale" means transaction other than sale by retail;

"wholesale vegetable market" means a place declared as a wholesale vegetable market under regulation 3.

3. The Authority may from time to time by notification in the *Gazette*—

Notification of area and wholesale vegetable market.

(a) declare an area as a specified area;

(b) declare a place in the said specified area as the Authority deems fit as a wholesale vegetable market for the said specified area.

4. (1) No person shall —

(a) in any specified area sell or purchase by wholesale or sell by retail any vegetable; or

Licensing.

(b) export any vegetable grown in any specified area

unless he is licensed in that behalf by the Authority;

Provided that this regulation shall not apply to a vegetable farmer selling his own vegetables.

(2) Where a wholesale vegetable market has been declared in any specified area, no person shall, at any place in the specified area other than the wholesale vegetable market, sell vegetable by wholesale unless—

(a) he is a vegetable farmer selling his own vegetables; or

(b) such vegetable has earlier been purchased at a wholesale vegetable market.

(3) Where a wholesale vegetable market has been declared in any specified area, no person shall, at any place in the specified area other than the wholesale vegetable market, purchase or obtain any vegetable for the purpose of sale by retail unless —

(a) he purchases such vegetable directly from the vegetable farmer who cultivated it; or

(b) such vegetable has earlier been purchased at a wholesale vegetable market.

5. Subject to these Regulations, no vegetable shall be sold or purchased in any wholesale vegetable market except by way of auction, private treaty or by such other method as the Authority may determine by way of conditions in the licence.

Methods of Sales.

6. Notwithstanding regulation 5, the Authority may declare itself to be sole auctioneer for any wholesale vegetable market.

7. (1) Where a wholesale vegetable market has been declared in any specified area, the Authority may declare by notification in the Gazette that no person shall export vegetables purchased from a specified area unless such vegetables have originally been purchased from a wholesale vegetable market in the specified area.

(2) The burden of proving that any vegetable was grown outside any specified area or that it was purchased at a wholesale vegetable market shall lie on the person charged.

8. (1) Any application for a licence mentioned in regulation 4 or the renewal thereof shall be in such form as the Authority may prescribe.

Application for

(2) Any such licence issued or renewed under paragraph (1) may be subject to such terms, conditions and restrictions as may be imposed by the Authority which may be varied at any time.

(3) Without prejudice to the provisions of paragraph (2), the following provisions shall apply with respect to every licence issued or renewed as aforesaid:

- (a) each licence shall expire on the 30th day of June next following the day it was issued; and
- (b) there shall be paid to the Authority such fee in respect of the licence as the Authority may impose.

9. (1) The Authority may by way of conditions in the licence require a person licensed under regulation 4 to issue —

- (a) a purchase invoice to the vegetable farmer or any other seller; and
- (b) a sale invoice to the buyer.

(2) A purchase invoice and a sale invoice shall be in such form and contain such information as the Authority may require.

10. (1) The licensee shall exhibit in a conspicuous position-

*Duties of
Licensee.*

- (a) in the premises or place of business specified in the licence, a board showing the prevailing prices at which he purchases or sells vegetables for the day and the deductions from the prices or the weight thereof which may be permitted under the terms of the licence issued to him;
- (b) over the door of the premises or place of business specified in the licence and in such manner as can be easily read by members of the public, his full name as appearing in the licence, in Roman letters, and the words-

PEMBELI SAYUR BERLESEN ; or

LICENSED VEGETABLE BUYER

PENJUAL SAYUR BERLESEN ; or

LICENSED VEGETABLE SELLER

PENGEKSPORT SAYUR BERLESEN ; or

LICENSED VEGETABLE EXPORTER

as the case may be.

(2) The licensee shall :

(a) furnish to the Authority information or returns as the Authority may require;

(b) display any other information and in such manner as the Authority may require.

(3) The licensee shall, on demand by an authorised officer of the Authority, permit the officer to enter the premises and shall if required, produce for the inspection of the officer, his licence and the register aforesaid.

11. (1) If it appears to the Authority that any person duly licensed under these Regulations has contravened or failed to comply with any regulation or any of the terms, conditions or restrictions imposed with respect to a licence issued to him thereunder, the Authority may call upon such a person to show cause why such licence held by him should not be cancelled.

Cancellation of licence.

(2) Any person called upon to show cause under paragraph (1) —

(a) shall be supplied by the Authority with the particulars in writing of the contravention or non-compliance complained of; and

(b) may, if he so desires, appear in person or be represented by any person authorised by him in writing, at a hearing before the Authority.

(3) If, after such hearing, the Authority considers that the person called upon to show cause has contravened or failed to comply with any of the provisions of these Regulations or contravened any of the terms, conditions and restrictions of the licence issued to him, the Authority may suspend or cancel the licence.

(4) The Authority, upon calling a licensee to show cause pursuant to paragraph (1) or at any time thereafter, and pending its decision as respects the cancellation or otherwise of the licence, may order a suspension of the licence.

12. Any person who contravenes any of the provisions of these Regulations or of any declaration made under regulation 7(1) shall be deemed to have committed an offence and shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding one thousand ringgit or to imprisonment not exceeding six months or both.

DECLARATION UNDER SUBREGULATION 7(1)

IN exercise of the powers conferred by subregulation 7(1) of the Vegetable Marketing Regulations 1975 [P.U.(A) 80/75], the Federal Agricultural Marketing Authority declares that no person shall export vegetables purchased from the specified area covering the area under the administration of the Johor Bahru City Council and the Mukim of Tebrau in the state of Johore, unless such vegetables have originally been purchased from the wholesale vegetable market at the Pandan Wholesale Market, Johor Bahru situated at the Pusat Perdagangan Pandan, Kampung Sri Purnama, Kangkar Tebrau, Johor Bahru, Johor Darul Takzim.
